First Aid Judge Instructions

Station 1

- 1. Introduce yourself to the team members.**
- 2. Take possession of the team scoring packet and locate the official Discount Card for your station and have the team captain fill in the required team information at the top of the card.**
- 3. Inform the team that they will draw lots to determine who will perform the CPR, Artificial Respiration, and the Foreign Body Airway Obstruction techniques.**
 - a. the team members should be reminded that this is not a team activity and therefore no coaching of the other member of the team will be allowed while at this station and**
 - b. the guidelines and procedures for the first aid contest contained in the 2006 edition to the M/NM National Mine Rescue Contest /Rules will apply including,**
 - c. the 7th Edition of the Brady "First Responder", will be used to settle any medical treatment issues that may arise.**
- 4. The team members will be further informed that they should listen to the judges for indications as to the status of victim's airway, breathing, and circulation.**
- 5. Issues regarding the sanitary use of the manikins will be reviewed.**
- 6. After lots have been drawn, start with CPR, then Artificial Respiration and then Foreign Body Airway Obstruction.**
- 7. Time will be used as required for specific discounts, but no overall time will be recorded for Station #1. Upon completion of all three parts of Station requirements.**
- 8. Discounts will be totaled and both judges will sign the card.**
- 9. Place the official discount card back in the team scoring packet and return the packet to the team captain.**
- 10. Upon completion of the problem the judges may review the discounts with the team and debrief them on their performance at that station.**
- 11. Hold the team at your station until one of the First Aid Contest Coordinators indicates the team should move to the next station or that they may leave the contest area.**

STATION TWO

An employee was assigned to perform clean up on the surface No. 2 belt conveyor. The miner was using a Bobcat skid steer to assist in the task.

The conveyor tailpiece became plugged, so the miner exited the skid steer to work on the conveyor. The Bobcat began to roll down the slight grade as the miner exited the machine, pinning the employee and dragging him under the front of the skid steer until the machine came to a stop on the level surface.

A co-worker heard the victim's cries and called for the first aid team. When the team arrives on the accident scene, they assessed the following injuries:

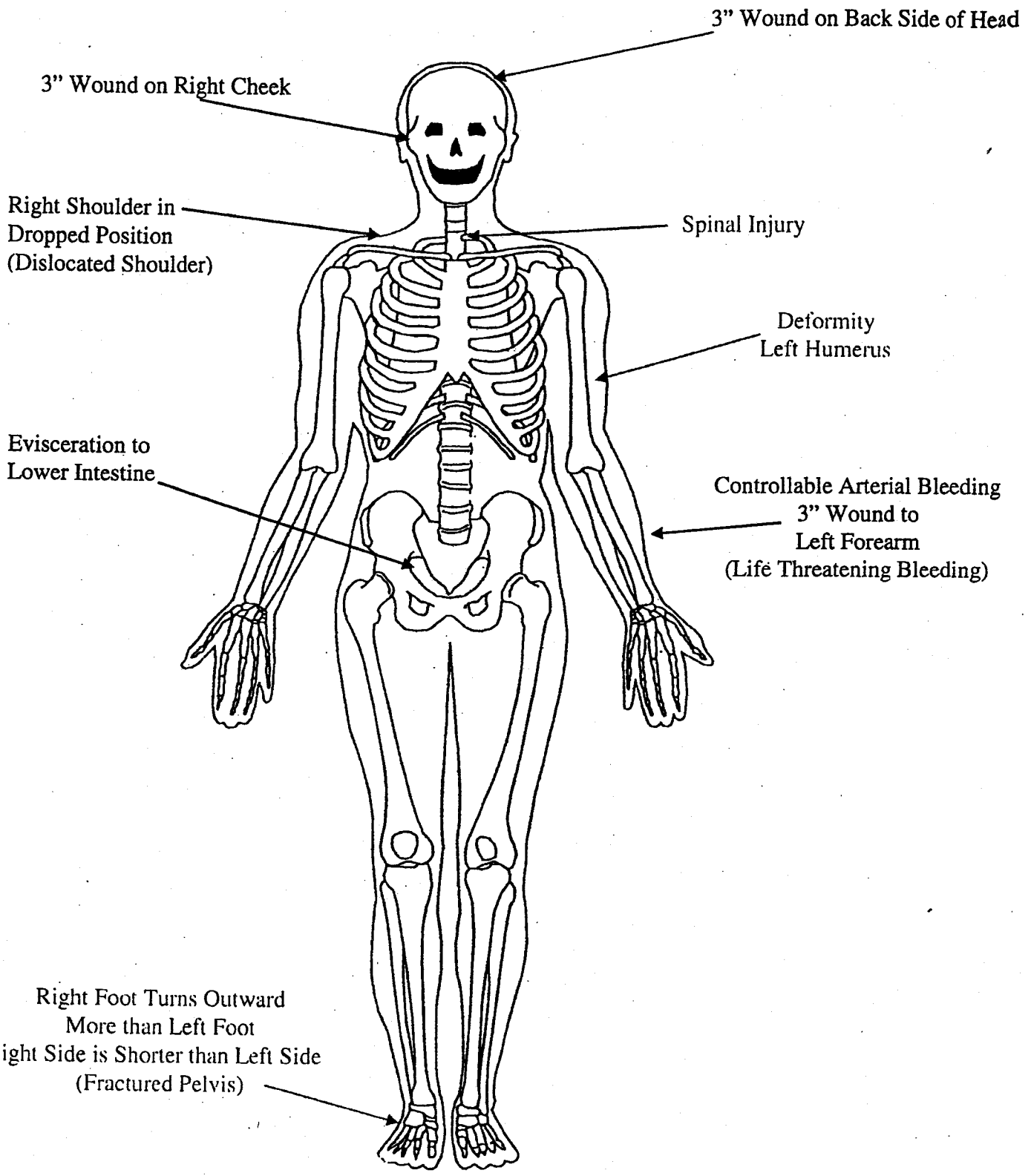
- Life Threatening Bleeding
- Spinal Injury
